Looking for a good reason to travel this fall? There are many. Following is an article by Mary Starr of the Brunswick News that not only gives you some good reasons, but also gives you some great options for places to go.

Off-season travel has benefits...

Empty nesters and other couples looking for a little **undisturbed romance** should begin packing their bags. Now. With children back in school, there's no better time to travel unhindered by hoards of children, precious though they are. And, because Labor Day signals the beginning of the off-season for many destinations, **saving money** might be possible, too. With a little planning, there are lots of possibilities.

Ann Owens, co-owner of Travel Service, on St. Simons Island, says that it's definitely less expensive to travel during the off-season. She recommends planning **September and October vacations** to Hawaii, Europe and Florida, south of Fort Lauderdale. The natural beauty and perfect climate are never out of season in Hawaii, but when crowds subside, so do the prices. Owens says that even **airfare is reduced**. Europe is another option. September and October are ideal months to travel to France, Italy and other parts of the Continent. "It's cooler, but things haven't shut down yet," Owens explained, noting the tendency to shut down tourist attractions in November and December, when the weather can be crummy and crowds are thin. "The snowbirds haven't arrived yet," she said. "And, once January arrives, it's high season again."

Kelly Dobbin, tour planner with Golden Isles Touring Co., says her favorite spots tend to **combine cultural and recreational pursuits**. The Lake Tahoe region of California and Nevada is perfect in early fall, with the weather still being warm enough to enjoy outdoor pursuits, such as boating, fishing and hiking. Dobbin is a fan of the Pacific Northwest, including Washington, Oregon and British Columbia, because the region is beautiful, the weather is cool and **there is a lot to do and see**. She also recommends San Francisco for its dining, shopping and culture, and is also enthusiastic about the Santa Fe, Albuquerque and Taos areas of New Mexico. Just out of town, Dobbin recommends Lake Lure for a romantic side trip. Outdoorsy types can participate in kayaking, whitewater rafting and hiking. Downtown Asheville is known for fine restaurants and has a **thriving live music scene**.

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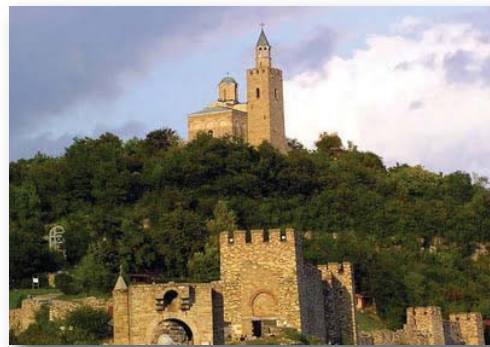


